

# Victorian review submission

VADANZ has called on the Victorian government to make changes to the way Voluntary Assisted Dying services operate in the state in its five-year operational review.

#### <u>Key recommendations</u> include:

- Medical practitioners and other health professionals should be able to initiate
  discussions with patients regarding VAD, within the context of end-of-life treatment
  options
- Allow patients to receive high-quality and effective VAD services using **telehealth**. Read more here.

NSW now has **250 doctors and nurse practitioners** who have completed the registration and mandatory VAD training requirements. Another **200** additional health professionals have started training.
